Mukwonago Resident Attended Rodent Control Academy in New York City

Mukwonago resident Dennis Olijnyk, an experienced field staff member of Batzner Pest Management, New Berlin, recently attended a Rodent Control Academy in New York City, sponsored by the NYC Health Dept. He participated in the educational program as part of Batzner's training and professional development programs, according to Jerry Batzner, the company president. Olijnyk, as a team leader for the company, trains new field technicians and staff, and helps solve on-going pest control problem accounts and situations.

Batzner said the academy was conducted by Dr. Bobby Corrigan, one of the world's foremost experts on rodent control. "Olijnyk learned how NYC handles rodent issues in schools, subways and other forms of public transportation, public housing, parks, and on the streets," he said. Olijnyk pointed out that rats are "diabolically clever," not the impulse machines they were once thought to be. They have the ability to analyze their surroundings and adapt to changing situations.

"To control a rat infestation you have to think about many factors contributing to a large and thriving rat population and address each one. The abundance of food and bad sanitation in large cities are major causes. We will use this information in training our technicians and when asked to evaluate long-term rat problems," he said.

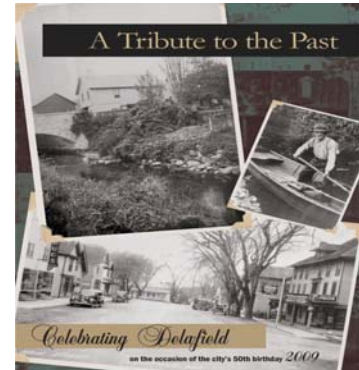
