Dr. Robert M. Corrigan

Dr. Corrigan has been active in urban and industrial pest management for over 35 years, and is the owner of Corrigan Consulting, where he designs urban IPM and Green Pest Management programs for cities and large corporations globally. Bobby has conducted training and consulting in over 45 states as well as in Europe, Asia, South America, and Canada.

Prior to starting his own firm, Bobby was a staff member at Purdue University for 15 years. He holds an A.A.S. degree in pest control; a B.S. degree in urban and industrial entomology from Purdue, and his Master's and Ph.D. in rodent and vertebrate pest management also from Purdue.

In the last two years, Bobby has appeared in Time Magazine, blogged for the NY Times, was featured on the CBS Sunday Morning Show and interviewed by NPR, the BBC and several international radio shows. In 2008, Bobby was inducted into the Pest Management Hall of Fame.

Wayne Kopp

Mr. Kopp, a Wisconsin Registered Sanitarian, has been employed by the Wis. Division of Health for 10 years, and by the Dept. of Agriculture, Trade, & Consumer Protection Division of Food Safety as a Certified Food Program Inspection/Training Officer for 15 years. He is a graduate of UW- Eau Claire with a B.S. in Environmental & Public Health. Kopp worked four years developing the FDA Model Food Code into the Wis. Food Code (adopted on 2/1/01), and is currently revising the Wis. Food Code.

Mr. Bruesch has over 35 years of professional rodent management experience. Beginning his career as a Service Technician, he was later promoted to Service Supervisor.
