

Cockroach Treatment Preparation

For optimal treatment effectiveness, follow the instructions below. Failure to do so will result in only bait being used instead of multiple treatment types, delaying overall effectiveness.

RESIDENTIAL PREPARATION

☐ 1. Empty Cabinets

All cabinets should be emptied before a service professional arrives onsite. This will allow proper treatment to these areas.

☐ 2. Move and Cover Dishware

Dishes, cookware, pet water & food bowls, and exposed foods must be moved out of the room and covered with a sheet so treatment will not contaminate these items.

3. Put Away Children's Toys

Children's toys must be removed from the area where treatment will occur.

☐ 4. Pull Appliances Away From Wall

Appliances such as refrigerators, chest freezers, and ovens should be pulled out if possible to allow service professional to apply treatment to specific areas.



COMMERCIAL PREPARATION

□ 1. Prepare Food Before Treatment No food preparation should be done during your service treatment. If preparation is in progress, all exposed food needs to be covered. In addition, all dishes, utensils, and cookware need to be covered as well. If this is not an option baiting will be the only treatment available.

2. Cover Bars and Buffet Lines Salad bars and buffet lines need to be covered with plastic or nonabsorbent material if treatments are being done in the same room to avoid contamination.

3. Pull Appliances Away From Wall Appliances such as refrigerators, chest freezers, and ovens should be pulled out if possible to allow service professional to apply treatment to specific areas.



PETS/ANIMALS

1. Remove Any Pets or Animals From Area Dogs, cats, birds, and reptiles should be removed

from the area of treatment and placed in a room where treatment will not be done. They must remain out of the area for a minimum of 1 hour after treatment has been completed.

☐ 2. Cover Fish Tanks

Fish tanks should be covered air-tight with plastic or nonabsorbent material to prevent any products from contaminating the water.
