Understand Why Mice are Entering Your Home

can gnaw on the wood beams, electrical wires and insulation. They are most often looking for warmth and shelter. Once they find this inside your home, they rarely venture outside again.

Avoiding Bed Bugs During Holiday Travel

The holidays inevitably leave many travelers staying away from home all across the country. Unfortunately, it's also a great opportunity to bring bed bugs home with you. Most people believe that bed bugs are only found in dirty, unkept conditions, but this is not the case. They can be found in economy motels, four star restaurants, grandma's house and everywhere in between. Here is how to be aware of bed bugs when traveling for the holidays.

Arriving at Your Destination

- **Bed bugs are least likely to be found in the bathroom**, so before you settle in, put your luggage there until you've had a chance to make sure the coast is clear.
- **Check the bed for signs of bed bugs.** Pull back all of the linens and check around and under the mattress and headboard. Look for little dots of blood, or black specs that look like mold or ground pepper.
- **Keep your eyes peeled for the**

bugs themselves. They are about the size of an apple seed and you might find them in corners or the seams of bedding. If you see any of these suspicious signs, make sure you alert someone.

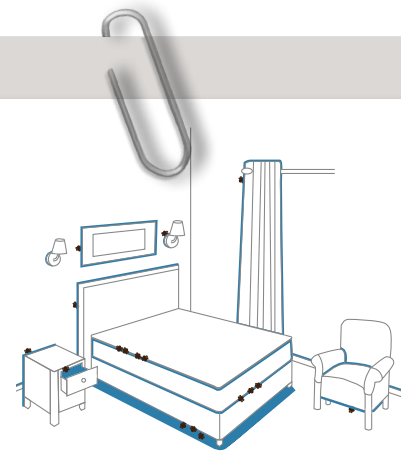
- **If you're in a hotel and you do end up moving to a new room, be sure the room is at least two floors away**, since it's a good chance that these bugs may travel through wallboards and electrical sockets.

During Your Stay

- **Keep your luggage off of the ground, or wrapped in plastic** for the duration of your trip. Large zip-up bags are available from luggage or travel retailers specifically for this purpose.
- **While there may not be any bed bugs in your room, the room next to yours may have them**, so taking a few simple precautions during your stay can be a great help in the long run.

After Your Travels

- **Heat is deadly to bed bugs.** Put items in the dryer for 30 minutes on the high heat setting, then wash with hot water, and then

dry once more to kill them. Bed bugs cannot survive in temperatures above 122 degrees.

- **Inspect and vacuum your suitcases**, and if you did invest in one of those zip-up bags, keep your luggage zipped up until it's needed again. Keep an eye out for any itching and welt-like bite marks on your skin. They normally show up in threes.

Q: We had a concerned customer of Oak Creek ask us on Facebook what kind of bug is making a home for itself in the picture below.



A: This is in fact a spotted grapevine beetle, or also known as the spotted June beetle. Because of its close resemblance to a ladybug, it is often misidentified as one.

Typically they are found in the northern and central parts of the United States, making Wisconsin the perfect home. They tend to gravitate towards wooded areas, thickets, vineyards and gardens. Because of this, you may find their eggs in rotten wood, tree stumps, or in nearby soil.

You may be surprised by how big they are. Grapevine beetles can grow up to 1.2 inches long, which causes them to be rather slow and clumsy when flying.

Adult beetles eat the leaves and fruit of grapevines, but not to worry, they will not damage your garden or vineyard. They are not a harmful pest, unless there is a large infestation of them, which is uncommon.

So how do you make them go away? These beetles are attracted to light at night, so turn off any outdoor lighting that they may be attracted to. Because they aren't damaging to your plants or garden there is no need to treat them. Keep an eye out during July, as that is when the adults emerge.
